## AGE DIVISIONS, as of January 1, 2020:

**WALK/TROT** is open to any age green rider or green horse and cannot cross enter into the above age divisions except for in Showmanship.

All youth and peewee riders must wear a helmet.  
HCBC Membership is required.

## CLASS DESCRIPTIONS:

**SHOWMANSHIP** ~ In hand, halter class where the handler is judged on how well they show their horse. Merit given to cleanliness, fitness and conformation of the horse.

**ENGLISH/WESTERN PLEASURE** ~ Judged on a horse that is a pleasure to ride. Manners, conformation and quality of movement is considered.

**ENGLISH EQUITATION/ WESTERN HORSMANSHIP** ~ Rider to be judged on correctness of their seat for their discipline. Pattern may be required.

**HUNTER UNDER SADDLE** ~ Horse is judged on movement, manners and suitability as a hunter without being shown over fences.

**RANCH RIDING** ~ The horse should reflect versatility, willingness and the movement of a true working horse through a pattern that may include obstacles such as ground rails or a gate.

**TRAIL** ~ This class is judged on the performance of the horse over and through obstacles, with emphasis on manners, response to the exhibitor, attitude and the ability to navigate obstacles with safety, alertness and caution.

# Spring Thaw Schooling Show \* SHOW RULES

## Show Rules:

1. Current HCBC rules will be followed. Current 2020 HCBC membership is required.
2. Please check to make sure your tack is appropriate for your discipline. If you're not sure, please feel free to ask on the day of the show!
3. Show is open to all breeds horses and ponies.
4. The show committee reserves the right to split, change, cancel or combine classes as it deems appropriate. The Show Committee reserves the right to amend show rules at any time. Especially in the case of concerns for safety of the exhibitors, horses and spectators.
5. Any horse that is disruptive and the Judge considers uncontrolled and/or a danger will be excused from the pen and NOT allowed back in. Exhibitors: You are responsible for your OWN supervision in the warm up arena. Any problems or issues of concern must be reported to Show Management.
6. Youth are REQUIRED to wear a safety helmet at all times. Safety is for riders and spectators alike. Crowding, standing or loitering at the in-gate and or in-gate area will not be tolerated. Safety Helmets must be worn by all Youth and by all age riders in all English classes.
7. Patterns will be posted for: Showmanship, English Equitation, Western Horsemanship, Ranch Riding and Trail.
8. **All AGES WALK/TROT and Green Horse:** Horses will be shown at a walk/jog/trot only. Exhibitors are NOT eligible for cross entry in other divisions of their respective riding classes but may enter their respective age division in Showmanship. Open to novice Exhibitors and green horses. Green horses are those in their first or second calendar year of being shown. Schooling equipment is permitted. Approved Safety Helmets with properly adjusted chin straps are mandatory in all Walk/Trot & Green Horse classes.
9. **Western Attire:** Neat and clean, suitable Western clothing. Jeans, heeled riding boots is a must. Chaps are optional. No rider will be penalized for wearing an approved safety helmet regardless of class entered.
10. **English Attire:** Neat and clean, suitable English clothing. Jackets optional, heeled English boots and riding helmets are a must.
11. Competitor numbers must be worn at all times.
12. Dogs must be leashed or tied up and cleaned up after...and preferably left at home.
13. Cash or e-transfers only please for entry fees.
14. Waivers and Helmet releases must be signed by all competitors.
